SAGA Foundation was founded by Ali Adil Khan after running the South Asian Gallery of Art (SAGA) for over 20 years. SAGA was established to promote, exhibit and sell works of emerging and established South Asian artists in North America.

Funding Overview

- Total funding: Up to a maximum of \$5,000 CAD per quarter distributed amongst successful funding applicants
- Frequency: All requests must be received by the end of each calendar quarter to be considered during SAGA Foundation's quarterly board meeting

Eligibility

- Resident of any country
- Dedicated full-time to a career in art
- Self-identify as South Asian
- Funding must be used for projects related to any of the following:
 - Education
 - Materials
 - Cataloguing
 - Exhibitions

Award Selection Criteria

Applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Specific - identified clear project objectives
- Measurable - defined success indicators
- Attainable - set viable budget and timeframe
- Relevant - demonstrated alignment with SAGA Foundation's mission and pillars
- Time-bound - showcased execution plan of <6 months
